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### Welcome and About EMIP

A new EU funded project, EMIP aims to support action to improve the mental health of Europeans.

EMIP is an acronym for "Implementation of Mental Health Promotion and Prevention Policies and Strategies in EU Member States and Applicant Countries". Initiated in August 2004, the EMIP project will run until July 2006. It brings together 8 European Networks and 12 national partners to share knowledge, information and experience on the determinants of effective implementation of mental health promotion.

The project works through national coalitions in the partner countries to build strong, multidisciplinary partnerships to improve mental health and well-being and prevent mental health problems. It brings together individuals and organizations committed to implementing an integrated mental health strategy in selected European countries.

In the course of the project, models of good practices on promotion and prevention will be presented during a series of National Workshops in:

**Austria, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia.**

The conclusions and recommendations from the National Workshops will be presented at a European Conference that will take place in March 2006 in Budapest.
